TRAIN A DOG -- SAVE A WARRIOR

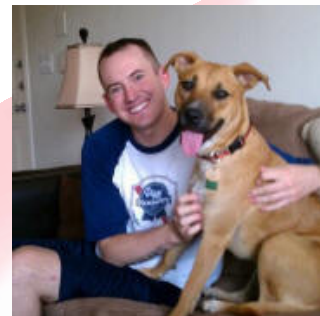
The TADSAW program uses young dogs that are trained by volunteers to act as companion “battle buddy” service dogs to returning warriors who are hobbled by traumatic brain injury or post traumatic stress syndrome. All the training and management are done by volunteers, but there are food, veterinary and warrior integration expenses needing support.



The cost to train and marry the dog to its selected warrior averages \$2,500. Our Community Service Project is to fund the training of one dog and warrior. There are currently funds to train 10 dogs. There are currently 300 warriors who have requested dogs.
